The enhancement and development of better implementation of environmental education (EE) in Hong Kong, especially in the formal curriculum is urgent and imperative as we have some 10 years left to limit climate change catastrophe. This seminar will cover the basic concept and objectives of EE and education for sustainable development (ESD). The underpinning psychological model towards environmental behaviour and the crucial *Three-fold Approach* of EE/ESD will be explained. The *Model of effective field-based environmental education* will be introduced as a tool for developing effective environmental education programmes. Finally the way forward for pushing the development of EE in Hong Kong will be discussed with recommendations.
